Strangers No Longer is a Community Organization, originally formed in SE Michigan by Catholic leaders in parishes in SE Michigan in 2017 around the civil and human rights of immigrants. Our primary structure of organizing has been through organizing teams ("Circles of Support") in parishes, high schools and immigrant communities. Those Circles of Support have provided education in the institutions, accompaniment to immigrant families in crisis and advocacy for humane policies and practices at the local and state levels. We are aspiring to become a statewide grassroots power organization based in institutions, primarily but not exclusively in churches and congregations.

We announce a position opening effective immediately (August 1, 2025):

- We are seeking to hire a full-time Community Organizer who will work as part of a staff team
  developing leadership in Circles of Support in immigrant and non-immigrant communities. This
  Community Organizer will be assigned to our Consejo Estatal (Statewide Council of Immigrant Circle
  Leaders) as well as non-immigrant Circles of Support. The starting salary range will be between
  \$45,000 and \$60,000 (depending on community organizing experience), plus benefits including a
  \$5000/yr. medical stipend and a \$1500/yr. internet/phone stipend. Travel will be reimbursed.
- Candidates must have some fluency in Spanish. Ideally, but not necessarily, the organizer will be based in SE Michigan.
